Pocket Money Beans are Healthy FUNdraising!

Students buy the specially marked FUNdraising packet of beans for \$2.00 and then they sell the beans they produce to their parents. There are enough seeds in each pack to produce a couple of kilograms of fresh beans, easily worth ten dollars to the child in pocket money.

Along the way valuable skills are learnt: a greater appreciation of the environment, healthy food is grown and hopefully (most importantly of all) a lifelong love of produce gardening is established.

FUNdraising packets of Pocket Money Beans cost sixty cents (\$0.60) per packet with a minimum order of twenty packets. Postage is additional, pickup can be arranged.

If the packets are sold for \$2.00, there is a fundraising of \$1.40 per pack to the Student Council.

The cost of the packets is the cost of materials and a small amount of pocket money for young IMBY helpers who packet up the seeds.
